



Hill Music *Lease Information Overview*

- Hill Music Rentals are available for student instruments of the type outlined on our price list.
- Rentals come with everything a student needs to get started playing: oils, reeds, resin, etc.
- All rentals are long term/rent-to-own with options:
 - You can return instruments before paying off your contract. There is no penalty for returning a rented instrument prior to paying it off.
 - You can trade an instrument in an active lease for another student instrument. Rental credit from the trade will be transferred to the new lease contract.
 - Pay off your instrument early. You will receive a discount on the remaining balance in effect at the time of your early payoff.
- The person who signs the lease contract is responsible for seeing that the instrument is maintained in good condition.
- A leased instrument is not considered returned until it is in the possession of either the Hill Music Store in Casper or a Hill Music rental outlet.
- Rental payments are charged via automatic debit to either a card or directly to an account.
- The person who signs the lease contract is responsible for updating card/account information with Hill Music in order to ensure payments are made as agreed.
- The rented instrument will remain the property of Hill Music until it is purchased.
- The person who signs the lease will be responsible for updating address and contact information with Hill Music. The contract will be in default if Hill Music is not made aware of a change in the location (player's physical address) of the instrument.
- Hill Music makes available a Repair and Replacement program for an additional fee that will pay for costs from accidental damage and theft of instruments that are on an active lease agreement.

This is a simplified description of some of the terms of our full lease agreement with the purpose of providing an overview and easy understanding. This is not the complete agreement. The complete lease terms will be provided at time of lease in conjunction with the description, value and payment plan for each particular instrument.
